Red Stag Hunting in Poland

Throughout history, great deal of prestige is awarded to hunters who shoot a mature stag! The red stag is the undisputed King of Europe's game animals - the trophy which all European hunters are most keen to hang on their wall. However, it is only when you have experienced the thrill of hunting during the height of the rut, that you really understand why this is.

The red stag is powerful, graceful - even majestic - and easily the most impressive animal in our forests. It is quite natural that all European rifle hunters will want to test their skills against this game - preferably more than once!

We can offer a wide range of the very best State Forest Districts in western Poland, all of which can deliver top quality red deer hunts. These State Forest Districts all have well trained, experienced and very responsible hunting guides, who each have their own areas in the districts, which they know like the back of their own hands.

The hunt usually takes the form of stalking or lying in wait on one of the towers that have been optimally placed in each district, with regard to the deer's behavioural patterns during the rut.

You will go out hunting twice a day, once in the early morning starting before dawn, and again in the late afternoon/evening during the hours around sunset. It will often be possible to combine stag hunting with a roebuck hunt, if the district has any left on its shooting quota, or with hunting for wild boar.

Accommodation is in a newly renovated hunting cottage in the district, from where, in September, you can hear the roar of the stags just outside the house. The guest accommodation is found on the first floor and consists of 1 single room, 4 double rooms, 3 3-bed rooms and 1 4-bed room. At fridge is at the guests disposal. In the basement there is a cosy sitting room with a fireplace, a dining room and a sauna. The accommodation is classifies as category "S". Guests have access to a lockable garage and cold store. The gamekeeper is called Franciszek Matysiak, and he can speak a little German. WiFi and mobile phone coverage are available.













RDLP Mrocleim



The Regional Direction of State Forests in Wroc?aw –the Regionalna Dyrekcja Lasów Panstwowych we Wroc?awiu, or in everyday speech the RDLP Wroc?aw - is our longest standing partner in Poland. We have been sending hunters to the districts managed by RDLP Wroclaw since 1978, when we used one of the districts. Now we use a total of 11 state owned districts, of which we have long term contracts with 6 of the very best. On the rest (= 22) of their total of 33 districts, the hunting is let out to various Polish hunting associations.

In common for all the state-owned districts under RDLP Wroc?aw, which in 2015 could celebrate it's 70th anniversary, is good, professionel and stabile game mangement, with each district having it's own speciality. Some of them stand out because of their fantastic stag hunts, others because of their well organized driven hunts - while some districts can simply do it all. More information given under the individual districts and we will of course be happy to provide more detailed information via telephone or email.

When hunting in a state-owned district accommodation is

normally provided in the hunting district itself – and not in a hotel in town. In this way our customers can enjoy a"total experience". The game is usually taken back to your accommodation so your hunting companions can join the celebrations. In some districts you can lie in bed at night and listen to the red deer stags roar during the September rut.

A hunt on one of the districts under RDLP Wroclaw is clearly a good choice!



The Zmigrod is our longest standing state hunting district, with whom we have been working in partnership with since 1978. It covers a total area of 27,284 ha., of which 11,202 ha. is forest, while the remaining 16,082 ha. consists of farmland, meadow, lakes and wetlands. The forest is made up of 64% coniferous trees, 14% oak and 14% alder. The district is predominantly flat. Zmigrod can offer 167 high seats/stands as well as 40 feeding places. It is possible to arrange an exciting hunt from a horse drawn carriage, providing you book this in advance. Up to 7 hunters can be taken at a time, but the optimal number is 4-5. Driven hunts can be arranged for groups of 10 - 14 hunters.

This district offers hunting for roe deer, red deer, fallow deer and wild boar as well as shooting for ducks and geese. Around 100 bucks are shot here every year. The trophy quality is very good, with a good chance of bagging a buck of 350g or above. There is an annual quota of 64 red stags - the majority of which have a trophy weight of between 5 - 7 kg, but stags of above 8kg are taken here every year. The district has nice Polish fallow buck, of which 20 are shot annually. The average trophy size is around 2.5kg. Zmigrod has a dense population of wild boar which can be

hunted on individual hunts throughout the season or on one of the 6 annual driven hunts, which normally give an excellent result, with a good mix of all species present.

Zmigrod is around 200- 260km from the border crossing at Forst/Olszyna - depending on which route you take- normally a 3 hour drive, 60km from Wroclaw, which is the nearest large town and 75km from Wroclaw airport, which is the nearest international airport. Wroclaw is a very exciting city and well worth a visit, especially if you have time to spare after your hunt is finished.
